**By-law Description:** A By-law to amend By-law 110-2013, being a By-law to Appoint Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for the purpose of enforcing the Smoking Prohibition By-law No. 052-2010, on the Thunder Bay Regional Health Sciences Centre Property.

**Authorization:** Report No. R 260-2014 (Licensing and Enforcement, Development Services) - Committee of the Whole – December 15, 2014.

**By-law Explanation:** The purpose of this By-law is to amend By-law 110-2013, being a By-law to appoint Municipal Law Enforcement Officers to enforce City of Thunder Bay Smoking Prohibition By-law No. 052-2010, only on the grounds of Thunder Bay Regional Health Sciences Centre Property and to update the list of current Officers authorized to enforce the By-law.

Report No. R 260/2014 was submitted to Committee of the Whole on December 15, 2014 which gave authorization to the General Manager of Development and Emergency Services to submit by-laws directly to City Council, to appoint new Municipal Law Enforcement Officers and to delete the appointment of inactive officers, as required.
