By-law Description: A By-law to authorize the execution of a Transfer Payment Agreement between His Majesty the King in right of Ontario, represented by the Minister of Transportation for the Province of Ontario (the 'Province') and The Corporation of the City of Thunder Bay (the 'Recipient') for the transfer of Phase 4 Municipal Transit Funding with respect to the Safe Restart Agreement (SRA).

By-law Explanation: The purpose of this by-law is to authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a Transfer Payment Agreement between The Corporation of the City of Thunder Bay and the Ontario Ministry of Transportation for the Transfer of Phase 4 Municipal Transit Funds.

A By-law to authorize the execution of a Transfer Payment Agreement between His Majesty the King in right of Ontario, represented by the Minister of Transportation for the Province of Ontario (the 'Province') and The Corporation of the City of Thunder Bay (the 'Recipient') for the transfer of Phase 4 Municipal Transit Funding with respect to the Safe Restart Agreement (SRA).

Recitals

1. City Council authorized the execution of an Agreement between The Corporation of the City of Thunder Bay (the "Corporation") and His Majesty the King in right of the Province of Ontario, represented by the Minister of Transportation for the Province of Ontario, related to the funding provided by the Province of Ontario (the "Province") to the Municipality under the Safe Restart Agreement (SRA) Phase 4 – Municipal Transit Funding by resolution of Committee of the Whole on February 6, 2023.

ACCORDINGLY, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF THUNDER BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Mayor and City Clerk are empowered and authorized to execute on behalf of The Corporation, affix the seal of the Corporation, and deliver the Agreement attached as Schedule "A" to this By-law and all subsequent year's agreements or amendments in respect to the Safe Restart Agreement (SRA) Phase 4 Municipal Funding Agreement, for the transfer of SRA funds.

2. This By-law shall come into force and take effect on the date it is passed.
