BY-LAW NUMBER 204-2023

A By-law to amend By-law 043-2016, being a By-law to provide a Property Tax and Water Credit Program for Low-Income Persons, pursuant to Section 107 (1) of the Municipal Act, 2001

Recitals

1. It is deemed necessary and expedient to amend By-law Number 043-2016, of The Corporation of the City of Thunder Bay by Resolution of Committee of the Whole on January 31, 2023.

ACCORDINGLY, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF THUNDER BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. By-law Number 043-2016 is amended by deleting paragraphs 7 and 8, and replacing paragraphs 7 and 8 with the following:

7. Total Credits provided for water relief for eligible properties shall not exceed \$20,000.

8. Total Credits provided for property tax relief for eligible properties shall not exceed \$20,000.

2. This By-law shall come into force and take effect on the date it is passed.
