BY-LAW NUMBER 95-2024

By-law 95-2024 - A by-law to amend By-law 075-2005, as amended, being a by-law to delegate Council's authority to execute certain agreements, in the City of Thunder Bay, in the District of Thunder Bay with respect to Section 1.01 (Definitions).

Recitals

1. By-law Number 075-2005 was enacted and passed on August 29, 2005, authorizing the delegation of authority to the General Manager of Development Services Department, or designate, to execute certain agreements regarding land development in the City of Thunder Bay, in the District of Thunder Bay.
2. By-law Number 74/2014 was enacted and passed on August 25, 2014, amending certain sections of By-law Number 075-2005.
3. City Council approved the recommendations of Report 064-2024 (Infrastructure, Development & Operations - Development Services) authorizing amendments to these by-laws to reflect title changes to certain positions due to recent reorganizational changes.
4. It is considered necessary and expedient to amend By-law Number 075-2005 and Amending By-law 74/2014, as set out in this further amending by-law.

ACCORDINGLY, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF THUNDER BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. With respect to By-law Number 075-2005, that Section 1.01 (Definitions) is hereby amended by deleting subsection 1.01(h) in its entirety and replacing it with the following:
 - (h) **“Manager”** means the General Manager of the Infrastructure, Development & Operations Department, or his or her designate.
2. With respect to By-law Number 075-2005, as amended by By-law 74/2014, that Section 1.01 (Definitions) is hereby amended by deleting subsection 1.01 (a.i) in its entirety and replacing it with the following:
 - (a.i) **“City Engineer”** means the Director of Engineering & Operations of the Infrastructure, Development & Operations Department, or his or her designate.

3. With respect to By-law 74/2014, that Paragraph 1. be deleted in its entirety.
4. With respect to By-law 74/2014, that Paragraph 2. be deleted in its entirety.
5. This By-law shall come into force and take effect on the date it is passed.
