A By-law to provide for the appointment of a
Chief of Fire for the Thunder Bay Fire Rescue and
The Corporation of the City of Thunder Bay

Recitals

1. The *Fire Protection and Prevention Act, 1997*, S.O 1997, c. 4 as amended, requires City Council to appoint a Fire Chief for the municipal fire department.
2. City Council authorized the appointment of a Chief of Fire for the Thunder Bay Fire Rescue and the Corporation of the City of Thunder Bay by resolution on June 10, 2024.
3. The appointment in this By-law replaces the January 22, 2024 appointment of Acting Chief of Fire David Paxton.

ACCORDINGLY, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF THUNDER BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT David Paxton be appointed to Chief of Fire of The Corporation of the City of Thunder Bay, effective June 24, 2024, at such salary as shall from time to time be set by the Council of The Corporation of the City of Thunder Bay.
2. AND THAT By-law Number 18-2024 be repealed.
3. This By-law shall come into force and take effect on the date it is passed.
