SUBJECT: Committee of the Whole Minutes June 3, 2024 Re: Surplus Real Properties – Woodside Parkette

I have been approached by Red River Ward residents living near the Woodside Parkette to ask for a deferral in the decision to surplus the parkette. The neighbourhood is proposing to create a plan for the parkette that would increase its use to the community. They are requesting six months to formulate that plan. I would like to support their request and ask that City Council defer the decision to surplus until January 13, 2025.

I present the following deferral motion for Council’s consideration:

WITH RESPECT to the Memorandum from Councillor Michael Zussino dated June 20, 2024, and the Committee of the Whole minutes from June 3, 2024 relating to Surplus Real Properties, we recommend that the decision to surplus the vacant property, municipally known as 172 and 168 Street, be deferred to January 13, 2025;

AND THAT this item be added to the outstanding list;

AND THAT any necessary by-laws be presented to Council for ratification.
