SUBJECT: By-law 391-2024 Appointment of Person to Enforce Parking

MEETING DATE: City Council - November 4, 2024

By-law Description: A By-law to amend By-law Number 99-2005, being a By-law to appoint Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for The Corporation of the City of Thunder Bay for the enforcement of Municipal Parking By-laws. This by-law will further amend By-law 99-2005 by correcting references to certain legislation and departmental authority.

Authorization: Report No. 2005.041 (Parking Authority) - Committee of the Whole - March 7, 2005.

By-law Explanation: The purpose of this By-law is to maintain an up-to-date listing of active Municipal Law Enforcement Officers (Development & Emergency Services Department/Parking Authority) by deleting the inactive Officers and adding the names of persons who will be enforcing Parking By-laws for the Parking Authority, the City, and Private Property Owners. The Police Services Act R.S.O. 1990, c. P. 15, was repealed on March 31, 2024, therefore this by-law will further amend references to legislation. With the reorganization of the Corporate structure, this by-law amendment will also correct the departmental authority.

BY-LAW NUMBER 391-2024

A by-law to amend By-law Number 99-2005, being a By-law to appoint Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for The Corporation of the City of Thunder Bay for the enforcement of Municipal Parking By-laws. This by-law will further amend By-law 99-2005 by correcting references to certain legislation and departmental authority.

Recitals

1. By-law Number 99-2005, enacted and passed August 8, 2005, authorizes amendments to update the appointment of officers as appointed by By-law Number 99-2005.
2. The *Police Services Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P. 15 was repealed on March 31, 2024 and replaced with the *Community Safety & Policing Act* 2019, S.O. 2019, c. 1, Sched 1., which came into effect on April 1, 2024.
3. Section 55 of the *Community Safety & Policing Act* 2019, S.O. 2019, c. 1, Sched 1. authorizes the municipality to appoint persons to enforce municipal by-laws.
4. Prior to the reorganization of the corporate structure in 2023, the Infrastructure, Development & Operations Department (Transportation & Works) oversaw the operations of the Licensing & Enforcement Division. This control is now under the Corporate Services Department.

ACCORDINGLY, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF THUNDER BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Schedule "A" – Municipal Law Enforcement Officers, is amended as follows:

2. Section 1 of By-law 99-2005 under Recitals is amended by deleting "Section 15(1) of the *Police Services Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P. 15, and replacing it with "Section 55 of the *Community Safety and Policing Act* 2019, S.O. 2019, c. 1, Sched 1.
3. Section 4 of By-law 99-2005 under Recitals is further amended by deleting the words "Transportation and Works Department" after General Manager of the; and replacing it with the words "Corporate Service Department."

4. This By-law shall come into force and take effect on the date it is passed.
